

Dear Colleagues,

The International Workshop on the "Physics Opportunities at an ElecTron Ion Collider" (POETIC 2012) will take place at the Indiana Memorial Union of Indiana University at Bloomington from August 20 to August 22, 2012. This workshop will be a satellite meeting of the Quark Matter 2012 Conference to be held in Washington D.C., August 13-18.

The primary goal of this workshop is to continue advancing the field of electron ion collider physics through a highly focused workshop, following the successful efforts of the INT 2010 fall program and a recent workshop at The National Institute for Theoretical Physics (NITheP), South Africa. At this time we feel the need to continually bring together the community, to facilitate collaborations and consensus, and to make a very strong physics case for a future Long Range Plan. We anticipate that in the long term this workshop will develop into a periodic gathering of researchers in the field.

While the central theme of the workshop will be the physics of an electron ion collider, the workshop will also cover the strongly related physics at the CEBAF, RHIC, and LHC experimental programs. The workshop will aim primarily at developments on the theory/phenomenology side, but experimental progress will also be addressed.

REGISTRATION

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The talks will be mainly by invitation only. The organizers expect to finalize the program by the end of April. Suggestions and inquiries regarding the program and speakers may be sent to the organizers at liaoji@indiana.edu.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport (IND). From the airport to Bloomington, it takes about 1 to 1.5 hours by car (about 50 miles). There are scheduled shuttles as well as limousine services between IND airport and Bloomington. More information will be provided on the Workshop website soon. Rental cars and taxis are available at the airport. Rental companies are located inside the airport terminal on the ground level. Limousine and shuttle services to Bloomington operate out of the Ground Transportation Center. For those coming from the Quark Matter Conferences, there are multiple direct flights in the Saturday afternoon and Sunday whole day, between IND and the Washington D.C. (IAD or DCA airports) and the duration is a little less than 2 hours. Book early to secure the flight at a low rate.

***Non U.S. citizens/residents traveling to the US to attend POETIC 2012 should check on visa requirements well in advance, and apply for a visa as early as possible, as visa wait times can range from several days to several months.
